### Class 1 **KBIS Insurance Senior British Novice - First Round/90cm Open**

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

First place rosette kindly sponsored by KBIS Insurance. Horses may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

#### **British Novice:**

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 125 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 316.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2014 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of four years or under in the same calendar year as the British Novice Final - in accordance with Rule 316.6

Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive. (See BS website for full details).

#### **90cm Open:**

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Open and British Novice sections split with 2 sets prizemoney awarded.

### Class 2 **Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery First Round/1m Open**

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

Horses (or ponies in pony competitions) may compete in one section only. In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

#### **Discovery:**

a) For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

b) For all horses born on or after 1 January 2013 irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6.

Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. (See BS website for full details).

**1.00m Open:**

For registered horses to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

Open and Discovery sections will be split with 2 sets prizemoney awarded irrespective of starters.

**Newcomers:**

Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds. Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

**RULES FOR UNAFFILIATED CLASSES**

In the event of insufficient entries lower prizes may be withheld. Rule - 76.6

Open to non-registered or British Showjumping Club competitors on horses and ponies. Senior riders should be turning 17 years old or older in the current year. Stallions are not permitted to jump in any Club classes.

Qualifying period: 1st July 2017 to 30th June 2018

Numbers to qualify: The Top 20 from each of the four height category league tables, will qualify for the National Club Championships held at the British Showjumping National Championships. Club registered horse(or pony)/rider combinations are eligible to qualify and in more than one height category.

Points 1st = 12, 2nd = 10, 3rd = 8, 4th = 6, 5th = 4, 6th = 3. Double Clear Points = 3.

Points are allocated depending on the number of starters; every one in five starters is eligible for points. If you gain a double clear you will receive three points regardless of starters. If a combination competes in more than two consecutive height classes per show day only the points from the bigger classes will be graded.

**This show is affiliated to Equifest.** The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground in 2019.

### Halifax Agricultural Show Equestrian Rules of Entry

1. 1<sup>st</sup> prize money will only be awarded in classes with up to 4 entries. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize money will be awarded in classes with 5 – 8 entries, 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> prize money will be awarded in classes with 9 or more entries.
2. All entries must be received by Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2018. We are unable to accept entries on the day other than pre entry competitors who may enter additional classes on the day.
3. SAE much appreciated with your entry for return of exhibitor passes and numbers.
4. The organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage, injury or accident to spectators, exhibitors, riders or their property as a result of attending this show. Please take appropriate care to prevent such accident or loss to yourselves and others. All competitors must hold suitable Public Liability insurance and a valid equine passport.
5. Riders must wear up to date hard hats secured with a chin strap. Hats which bear EN1384 or BSEN1384 along with another accepted standard, will be permitted. For example, BSEN1384 & PAS015 (1998 or 2011) along with the Kitemark or Inspec IC mark will be acceptable, but not BSEN1384 on its own. This also applies to handlers 15 years and under.
6. No persons other than the exhibitor, handler, judges and stewards are allowed into the rings.
7. No horse/pony under 4yrs will be allowed to compete in any ridden class.
8. No exercising of horses or ponies in the parking area. Please use the designated collecting ring only. No cantering/galloping outside of the competition rings. No lunging anywhere on the showground.
9. Age for horse/pony and rider as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018.
10. All stallions and colts should be suitably bitted and handled by persons 16 yrs. and over.
11. The organiser's reserve the right to divide, amalgamate or cancel any classes should entries warrant it.
12. If an entry is late for a class, due to competing in another ring, the judge may wait 5 mins, or allow late entry to the ring, entirely at his/her own discretion. No refunds will be made.
13. The Judge's decision is final. Any formal objections should be made in writing (official form available from The Secretary's marquee) and handed to the Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of £20, before leaving the show. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld and you will be notified of the decision by post.
14. No horse/pony to be left unattended tied outside a horsebox/trailer.
15. No mucking out on the showground and please take all litter home with you.
16. Mistreatment of any animal on the Showground will not be tolerated. The organisers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave.
17. By entering any class you agree to abide by the rules above. The above rules are additional to the general show rules.
